Greek Words

Pure- HAGNOS, hag-nos'; from the same as Hagios, properly clean, i.e. (figuratively) innocent, modest, perfect:--chaste, clean, pure.

Pure- KATHAROS, kath-ar-os'; of uncertain affinity; clean (literally or figuratively):--clean, clear, pure.

Holy- HAGIOS, hag'-ee-os; from hagos (an awful thing); sacred (physically pure, morally blameless or religious, ceremoniously consecrated):--(most) holy (one, thing), saint.
